I understand and agree that there are many risks involved in riding, driving, and being near horses. Among other things, horses are unpredictable by nature. For example, when frightened, angry, or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, back up, or run away from danger by trotting or galloping. Horses are also known to kick, buck, rear up, strike, or bite. I know that horses can do any of these things without warning. I also understand that all horses are powerful and can be dangerous.

I understand that anyone riding or near a horse can suffer bodily and other injuries. The owners of the horses, the owners of the land, the riding instructor, and the stable cannot guarantee my safety.
